Historical Understanding	To deepen knowledge of historical fascism in Europe, by analysing its origins, ideologies and consequences.

Civic Engagement Impegno civico	To encourage pupils to become actively involved in projects or actions aimed at promoting active citizenship and combating political extremism.
Linguistic Competences Competenze linguistiche	To improve pupils' language skills by encouraging intercultural communication and the use of different languages as part of the project.

Raising Awareness of History and Remembrance Sviluppo della coscienza storica e della memoria	To raise students' awareness of the importance of preserving collective memory and preventing the repetition of past mistakes by studying historical fascism.

These pedagogical objectives aim to provide students with an in-depth understanding of the history of fascism in Europe, while encouraging them to become active and engaged citizens in contemporary society.
